Granada TV w 8 Chapter Stops. Recorded in May and broadcast Aug 19, 1964. Filmed at Wilbraham Road Railway Station, Manchester, Greater Manchester, England, UK in front of 200 English fans.

BURT BACHARACH SOUND

Burt Bacharach recorded at Chelsea Palace studio with Dusty Springfield, Dionne Warwick, The Searchers, The Merseybeats and Chuck Jackson. The film is introduced by Marlene Dietrich. Burt Bacharach drives around London in a convertible, describing his songs, while singers interpret them in the studio. Director: Philip Casson. Producer: John Hamp. UK - ITV network Granada program. Broadcast April 14, 1965.

In this performance, Dionne blows Dusty off the stage.
