

well know for it's speed issues but that is just the beginning. Tracks 04 and 14 were sourced from a tape making the rounds known as the "Cheap Trick" tape. The CT tape suffered from being off pitch and also had a whining noise running through the tape. The noise however was only present on the tracks, there was silence between the tracks so the noise came from a prior source, before it was compiled into the CT tape. When these tracks were mastered for the FTF lp they were also speed-up adding to their problems.

What I did was start out by doing a new capture of the original source tape for FTF and running it through an equalizer. I don't like to do this normally but I wanted to see if I could capture more of the track and eliminate some of that whining noise before the digital transfer. Once in digital I used Adobe Audition to do a "Capture Noise Reduction Profile" on just the whining noise to remove it from the tracks. The noise was more pronounced on the left channel then on the right so I treated each channel seperately. You'll notice I also removed some noise on the Orange cd tracks. These tracks still had some of that same noise, which was also more pronounced on the left, and confirms that Orange used the same CT tape source for their release. With the noise removed I did a speed correction on the tracks and on tracks 04 and 14 I also did a pitch correction. Track 13 didn't need the pitch correction as it doesn't originate from the CT tape. I was pleased with the sound of track 4 as it has a more raw sound to it then the Orange release. Let me know what you think.

Notes:On tracks 2-4 I ultimately decided to use the tracks from Yellow Dog/Orange CD 018 "Miscellaneous Tracks" even though they are not my personal choice. I feel there is too much processing on their version. And while they sound cleaner I think there is something lost in the process. That is the reason I have included three alternate versions in the "extra" folder so you can judge for yourselves.

This may not be the ultimate "Fulfilling The Fantasies", as I'm sure there are better copies of some of these tracks still out there some where, but by using widely available recordings I believe I've created a better version of the original LP. I hope you enjoy it.

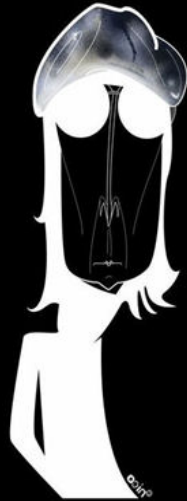
