It doesn't hurt that I saw him the same week as each one of the 4, but each in their own way they are essential. I have been collecting Iggy stuff for a long time. To come across four such crucial uncirculated shows has been amazing for me. This one is no exception. When you think about it there really are not many decent LFL tour shows out there. The Hippodrome, a few songs on TV Eye Live, San Diego (which was an a-typical setlist) - pretty slim pickins for that tour. This is a great performance of a typical 10/77 setlist. It is a clear capture with no issues. The live sound is a little echo-y, but that was the case for the whole tour - a really unique live sound. And, Soupy Sales delivers the intro. Merry Christmas.
