John Fahey, one of them eccentric eclectic geniuses that we don't have enough of these days, but that's what you'd expect from a person with degrees in philosophy and religion. Fahey comes from the school of Mississippi John Hurt, Skip James and Blind Willie Johnson. He helped the career of Leo Kottke and started his own record label which included a roster of artists such as Maria Muldaur, The Fabulous Thunder Birds, Leo Kottke and Mike Bloomfield. In the mid 80s I was able to experience John Fahey up close and personal at the Post and Beam Coffee House in Kingston, RI... one of those events that sticks with ya for a lifetime.

This DVD is a great companion to the Leo Kottke Rockpalast I posted here recently.

Thanks to the original poster and seeder of this John Fahey concert. He was at his best here.
